Please can I remind parents and carers that SATS assessments are going ahead this year.

KS1 - The Key Stage 1 tests will be administered during May 2022 and will start from Monday 2nd May.

KS2 - SATs week is Monday 9th May to Friday 13th May 2022.

Also, ALL children in Year 4 will be taking the Year 4 Multiplication check between Monday 6th and Friday 24th June. This check is to determine whether pupils can recall their times tables fluently, which is essential for their future success in maths. Please continue to support your child by practising times tables with them regularly at home too.
