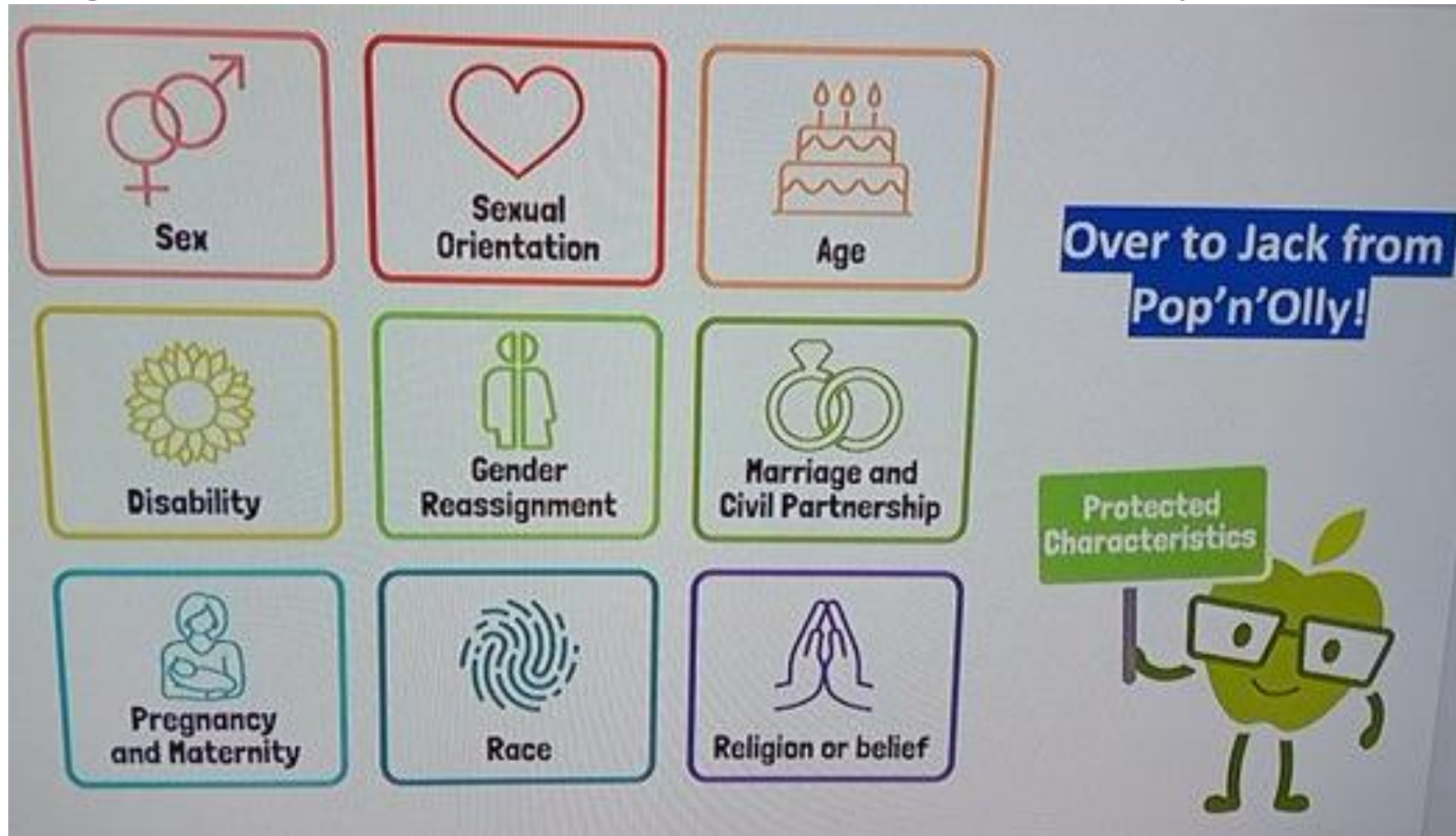




During Safeguarding week in school, we invited @SquaringUp_ to speak with our children about anti-social behaviour.

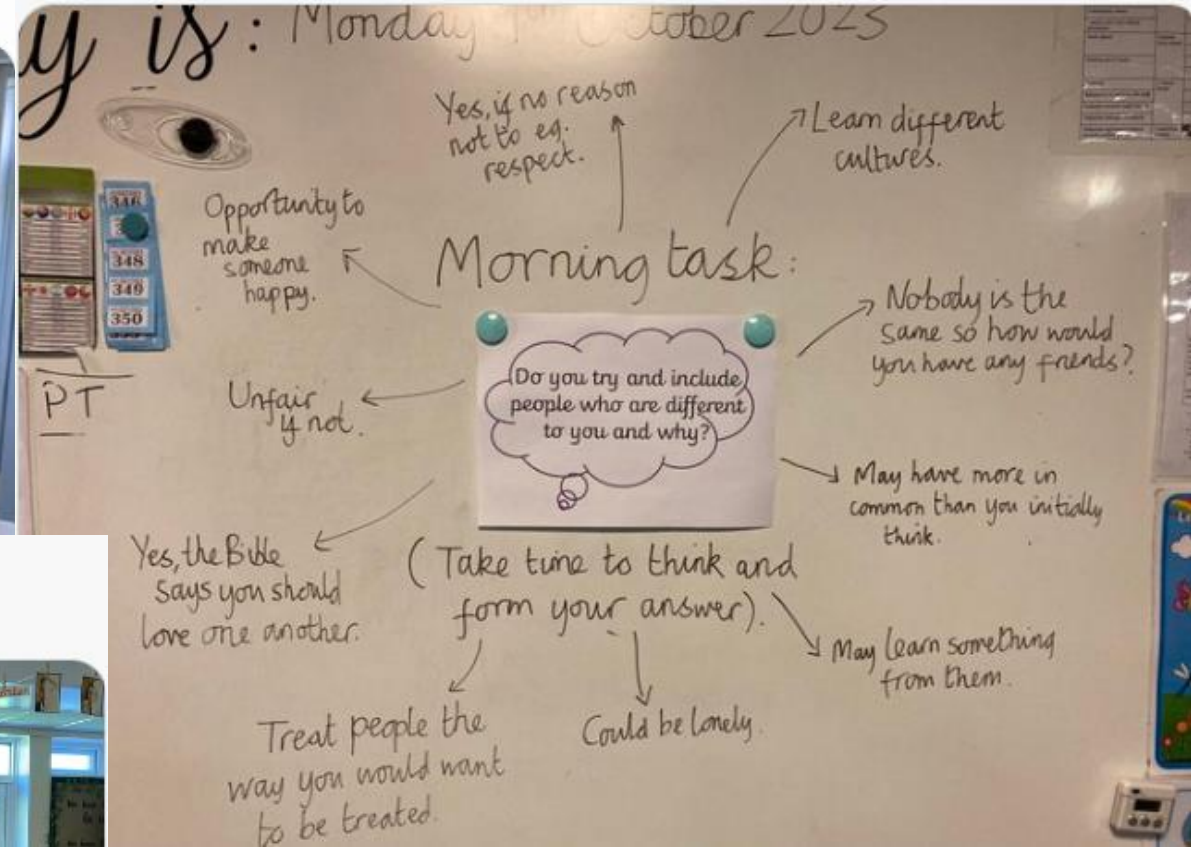

May learn something from them. →

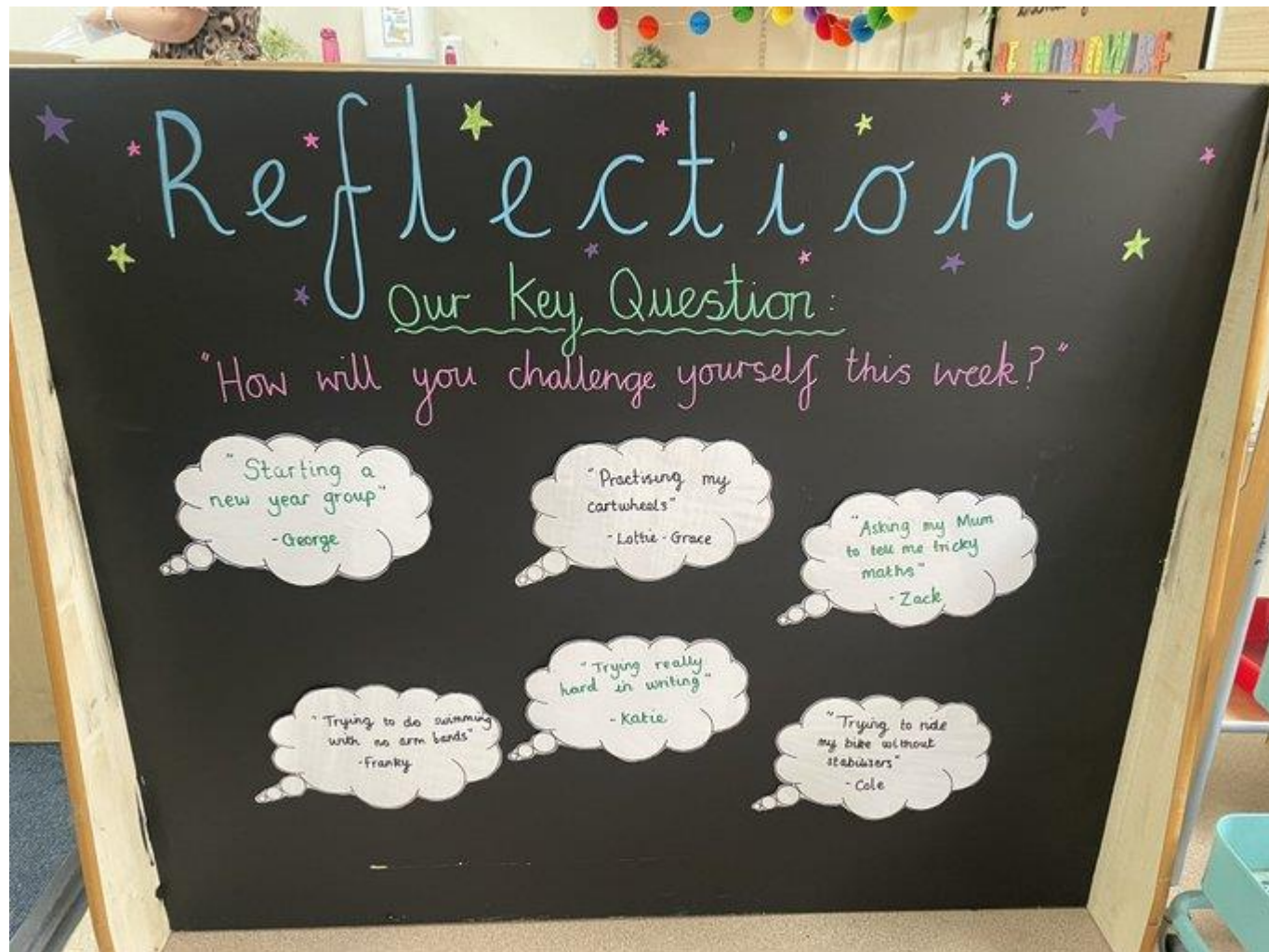
Treat people the way you would want to be treated.

Could be lonely.



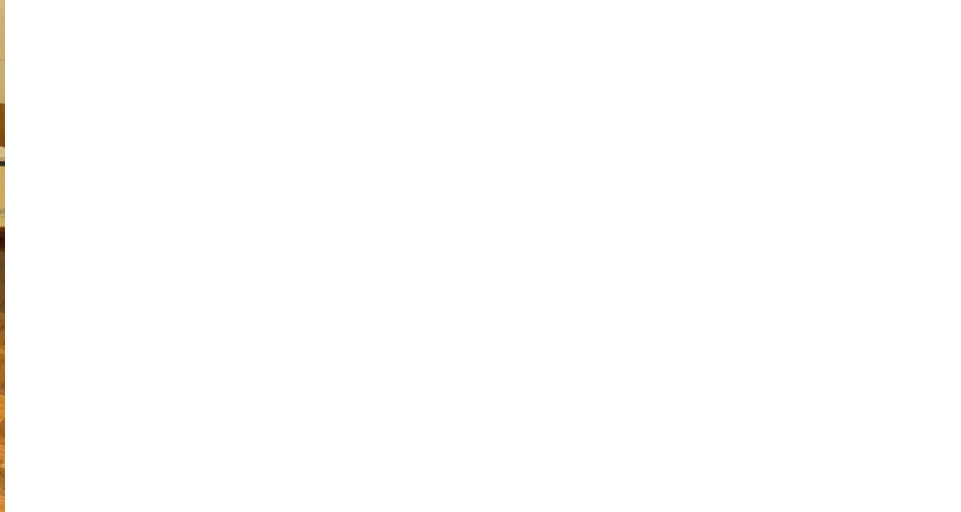
